### FAMILY ENVELOPES ...

We are GOING GREEN! In an effort to reduce our paper use and be more environmentally conscious, we will begin sending this monthly *Parent Page* and other parish information and flyers home via email next month. Items which cannot be sent electronically will still come home in a Family Envelope. **Please be sure to sign the envelope and return it with your child to the next class.** The youngest child in each family will be handling the envelope.

### Train to be a Reader - Grades 2-5

### Altar Server Training Signup - Grades 5 & Up

Training for new altar servers will take place on **Saturday, November 13**. Candidates can select either the **9:30 am** or the **1:00 pm** training session. All boys and girls in **Gr. 5 and up** are eligible. Sign-up forms will be distributed through the RE Office. Existing servers need not return the forms or attend this training.

## Growing Peace at Ascension



Again this year the Religious Education classes in Grades 1-8 will participate in **GROWING PEACE AT ASCENSION**, an effort to promote the Christian virtues of peace and nonviolence in the classroom and in the family. Each family is encouraged to take the Family Pledge of Nonviolence (either the regular pledge or the version for younger children—included in your Family Envelope with a paper dove). **If your family takes the Family Pledge, you are encouraged to return the dove with your family name written on it.** The doves will be displayed on the wall outside the RE Office during the year. Throughout the year the RE classes will be working on all components of the Pledge. Each concept is covered in the booklet, **Families Creating Circles of Peace**. Families are encouraged to use one or more of the activities. Replacement copies of the booklet are available in the office at cost. Students who are observed living out Christian peacemaking virtues will be given a certificate of recognition and the student's name will be entered in a monthly drawing to receive a "peace bear." Each class will sign a Classroom Pledge. Grades 6-8 during a prayer service; Grades 1-5 will sign the School Pledge at the Thanksgiving Mass.

## March for Life extended trip to Washington DC -2011

You will be receiving a letter telling which outreach ministry your child will be learning about this year. A representative from each outreach will come to the classroom and talk about their ministry and how the class can support them throughout the year. It is our hope that in this way our students will have a better understanding of each of the outreach ministries we do here at Ascension as they move up through the grades.
