### Current Classroom Collections (managed by 5<sup>th</sup> grade)

#### Writing instruments

**Any brand**

**Elmer's brand ONLY at this time**

#### Scotch Tape

**Any brand**

ANY empty transparent tape dispensers and/or empty roll cores. (Plastic only--remove cardboard or paper labels.) Place in collection bins at PTO meetings.

### Current Other Collections

#### Coffee bags

**Any brand**

Bags only, no cans. These will also be collected at the fair trade sale table at "coffee & donut Sundays" after Mass.

**\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE:** Each collection must be sorted and sent in as separate shipments in order for PTO to receive credit. ***If you are using the collection bin in the school entrance, PLEASE sort your items before bringing them in.*** For example, do not fill a coffee bag with pens and a few chip bags, do not fill a chip bag with juice pouches and glue sticks, etc. Leaky juice pouches make a mess for the students who have to sort the items and **MUST** be brought to school in SEALED bags if they are not put directly into the lunchroom collection bin.
